Gifted and Talented and Odyssey of the Mind Updates

- Partnership with Wilmington University to offer Gifted and Talented courses for interested staff to work toward certification
- Extended Learning Opportunities have now started at all elementary schools
 - Mispillion and Banneker 3, 4 & 5 led by Dr. Gaglione. Miss Fitzpatrick is providing Gifted and Talented services for grades 4 & 5 at Ross.
 - Services have begun for students who have proven their specific creative or academic abilities; but, don't qualify for TEAM through intellectual ability measures.
 - Elementary Gifted and Talented teacher is now directly servicing 143 students.
- Dr. Gaglione has provided training to elementary staff
 - Differentiating for High Ability Learners at Ross & Banneker (Mispillion had the training last year)
 - Provided additional resources during Morris and Ross Staff Meetings regarding High Readers. Banneker Staff will be receiving this training in January.
- Currently there are 6 elementary Odyssey of the Mind teams, with 3 being coached by a staff and parent team and 3 by parents.
