CURRICULUM ADVISORY COUNCIL

The purpose of the curriculum council shall be to strengthen the school district's

educational program. The council will develop long range plans in areas such as the

continuing development of curriculum, instructional techniques, teacher supervision, in-

service training, staff development, pupil testing, philosophy and goals of the school

district, and other instructionally related matters.

The council shall consist of the Directors of Teaching and Learning and Student Support

and Parent/Community Services (co-chairs), the principal and one teacher from each

school. The Superintendent or designee may function as an ex-officio member of the

council. All teacher members of the council shall be elected by vote within each of the

different school buildings.

The council shall meet in February and July each year and at the call of the

chairpersons or the Superintendent. The council shall establish its own rules of

procedure, and the co-chairs will be responsible for the arrangement and conduct of the

meetings.
